Because of you, care lives here, in our House in Vancouver and our in hospital Family Rooms in Kamloops, Surrey, and Prince George.

Ronald McDonald House BC & Yukon is more than accommodation; it's a place to stay strong. In 2025 because of you, families found care in everyday moments together that helped life feel a little more normal. Care lived in the programs provided by staff and volunteers, and in the community they found here with other families who understood what they were facing.

76,562 meals prepared with care, so parents could rest and reconnect after long days in the hospital.

1,311 hours of wellness programs in art, music, and play that helped children express what words could not.

Safe, welcoming spaces where **1,026** siblings could laugh, learn, and continue growing together.

Bringing care closer to home

More families across BC and Yukon need to travel for their child's treatment, and with your help we are growing to meet the need. In 2025 we opened two new Family Rooms in Kamloops and Prince George, offering both overnight stays and day visits.

Just steps away from their child's bedside, Family Rooms allow caregivers to rest, grab a quick meal, do some laundry or take a shower, ensuring that whole families are able to stay in their child's fight.




