Ronald McDonald House Helps to Ease Financial Burden

Ronald McDonald House BC & Yukon saves families over **\$11.2** million annually, in out-of-pocket expenses like lodging, food, and other essentials.

This is a **16%** increase in savings from 2024





For many families in Canada, it is too expensive to have a sick child.

Without Ronald McDonald House, a family could incur up to **\$23,267** in out-of-pocket expenses to be by the side of their sick child for a 1-month hospital stay.

For many families in Canada, the financial costs leave a lasting effect.

At the Vancouver House, this represents 26% of a BC family's annual disposable income and could take 10+ years to pay back.

Miscellaneous expenses	\$1,226

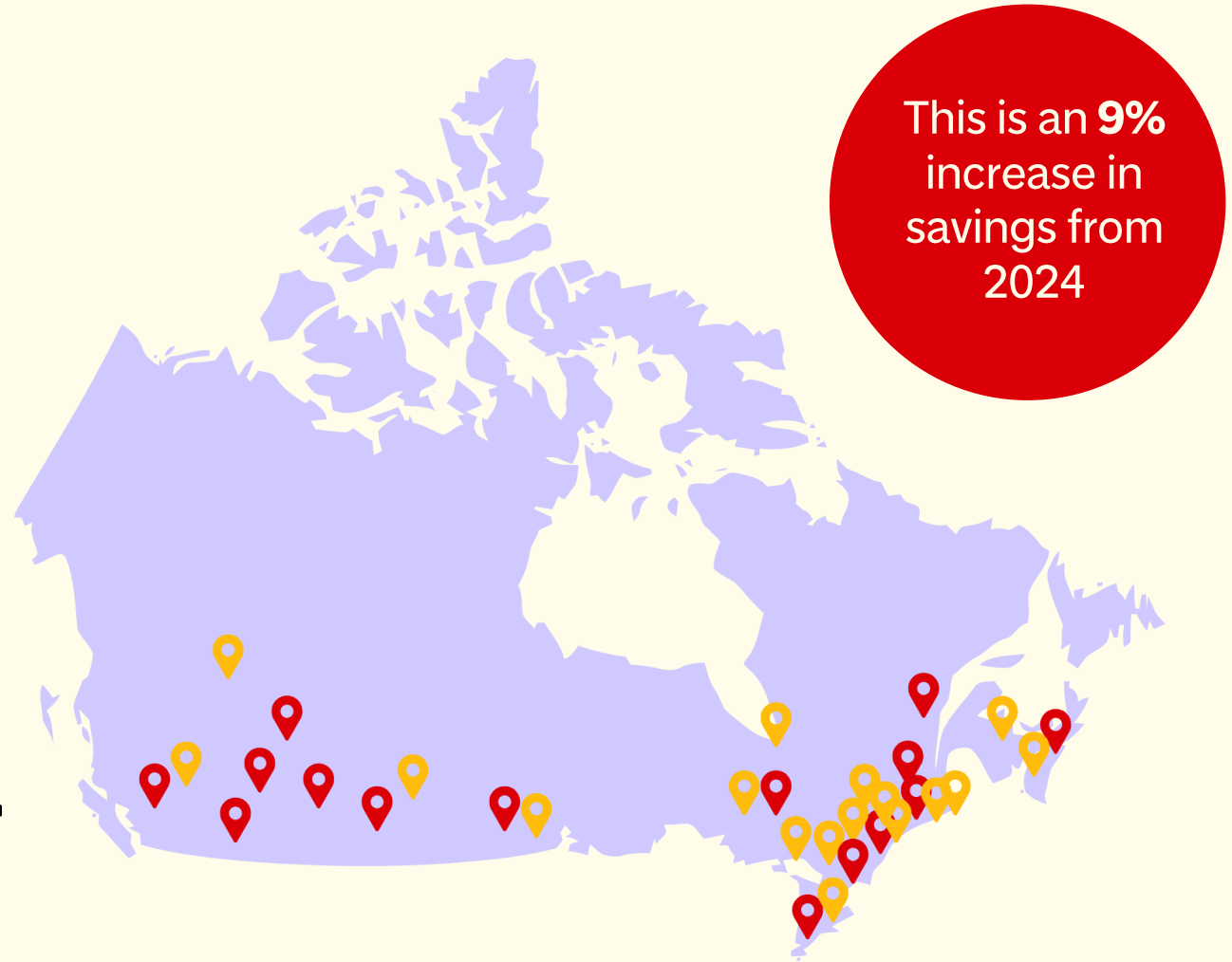
With our planned expansions, we will increase our total family savings to \$22.8M each year.
